Option 2: The individual holds an associate's degree in a field related to education, child development, human services or recreation from an accredited or approved institution of higher education.

Option 3: The individual holds a bachelor's degree or higher in a field related to education, child development, human services or recreation from an accredited or approved institution of higher education.

Option 4: The individual holds a master's degree in a field related to education, child development, human services or recreation from an accredited or approved institution of higher education.
