We Are Taking a "Pause"

In compliance with Governor Gina Raimondo's executive order announced last week, the Newport County YMCA will **temporarily close most of our facility and programs for two weeks starting on Monday, November 30th until Sunday, December 13th.**

Earlier this month, our YMCA was visited by a Business Inspector from the Department of Business Regulation for the State of RI to inspect our COVID-19 protocols and regulations. Not only did we pass, but the inspector that visited us said that our facility was the **best that they had seen in over 1,000 businesses in the state!**

We are incredibly proud of the efforts of our staff and members since we reopened our doors on June 4th. We will continue to provide this level of service to the community **once we reopen on Monday December 14th**, however we cannot do this without your support.
