On 11/14 the Town of Middletown will authorize the Newport County YMCA to" submit a request to the HUD administering agency for the release of Community Project funds under the Act, 2022, (P.L. 117-103), to undertake a project known as the renovation and expansion of the Newport County YMCA for the purpose of a capital project to renovate and expand the Newport County YMCA.

An Environmental Review Record (ERR) that documents the environmental determinations for this project is on file at the Town of Middletown.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Town of Middletown. All comments received by 11/14 will be considered by the Town of Middletown prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of fund and the Newport County YMCA certification for a period of 15 days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Town of Middletown; (b) the Town of Middletown has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD administration office at 1350 Pennsylvania Ave NW Ste 317, Washington, DC 20004. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
