**Registration Fee:** \$60.00 yearly fee due at the time of registration (non-refundable)

#### **Tuition:**

- Weekly payments must be automatically drafted from a checking, savings, or credit card. Please complete the auto-debit form attached to the registration packet.
- Payments are drafted on Monday of the week prior to attendance.
- DHS Certificate must be submitted and approved prior to attendance (if applicable).
- Two week notification must be submitted to the Director, along with an updated auto-debit form, if you need to cancel or change your preferred method of payment.
- A \$30.00 fee will be applied to your payment if it is returned.
- A \$20.00 late fee added to late payments.

#### **Registration Options:**

- TAN School Year: 41 week program, September-June
- TAN Summer Program: 9 weeks, 6/22/26 – 8/21/2025
- TAN Year Round program, 50 weeks/year

**Ages:** Children ages of 18 – 36 months

#### **Hours:**

- Hours of operation are 7:30am to 5:00pm.
- Children should arrive prior to 10:00am. If your child will be dropped off after 10:00am, please inform the Director and/or classroom teacher.
- Children should be picked up no later than 4:50pm. This pick-up time allows the teachers time to clean the classrooms and exit the building.
- There will be a late fee charged for any child that remains at TAN past 5:00pm.
